A complete credit evaluation and intake survey will allow you to take the courses you need to achieve the requirements of your high school diploma or prepare you to for an adult diploma or GED. While participating in a variety of learning opportunities, you will be able to earn your credentials while exploring careers of interest, earn career certificates or participate in college level courses to increase your job skills and participate in work experience or internship opportunities.

Flexible Schedules

Schedules designed to meet your needs

You will be scheduled for courses based on your individual needs. Evening and weekend hours will be available for students who need flexibility due to work schedules or other obligations.

High School Diploma

All courses aligned to high school credit requirements

Career Certificates

College level career certificates embedded into program

Unique to the Academy and Career Center @ 800 West Broadway is the ability to earn Career Certificates that increase your employability in certain fields. Initial certificates will be offered for Health Care Core, Translation Services and Business Communications & Technology Essentials. More are being developed to meet the needs of high demand job areas. Course work for the certificates will be aligned to high school credit as well, so you can earn your high school diploma at the same time.
